

Welcome back to the 2025 school year! I hope you have had a wonderful Christmas break and are feeling excited about the year ahead.




New Refurbishments

PBL – Positive Behaviour for Learning

Depot Hill State School is a Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) school. This means that we believe that recognising the student's positive behaviours will encourage them to repeat these behaviours leading to greater learning outcomes. As such, each classroom has a positive behaviour system set up to reward the students who are making good choices throughout the day.

The students will be rewarded with raffle tickets at the end of the day, and each week, on parade, we will pull student names from the box of raffle tickets to earn a Zooper Dooper. Our goal as a whole school is to have 3000 raffle tickets in our whole school box. When we reach this goal, the whole school will receive a reward, such as an excursion to the pool or park. Please check in each day with your child to see how many raffle tickets they have earned and praise their efforts. Parade is held each Monday at 2.30pm. Swimming

Depot Hill has always highly valued Learning to Swim and we therefore teach swimming in Term 1 and 4 of each year. Our swimming lessons will begin next Friday, 7th February. Please complete the attached permission form and return as soon as possible so that your child can attend. Not only is learning to swim a life-saving skill, it is also part of the Australian Curriculum and therefore compulsory. The cost will be \$10 per child which can be paid with cash or eftpos at the office. This money goes toward the cost of the bus and the swimming instructors. 
WELCOME MRS LAWTON

Primary School Nurse Health Readiness Program

How can parents/guardians access the Vision Screening & Privacy Online Consent Form?

This form can be accessed on computers, mobile phones, and tablets by following the link distributed by the school via email or text message. It is available to access on 3G networks.

Parents/Guardians may also access the form by scanning the QR code displayed on the classroom poster using their mobile phone or tablet. It is requested that these posters (attached to this email) are printed and displayed outside of each of the Prep classrooms.

What happens if a parent/guardian tries to access the link after it has closed?

If a parent clicks on the link after the closure date, they will be provided with an option to download and print a paper copy of the consent form. This should then be returned to the school prior to the date of screening.

Will school staff be able to find out who has completed a Vision Screening & Privacy Online Consent Form? The Registered Nurse will provide you with a list of children that have returned a consent form via the online portal. The Registered Nurse will inform you of when you can expect to receive this list. We would ask your assistance in following-up with the families that have not yet returned a form, to provide them with the opportunity to participate in this important health initiative.

DEPOT HILL STATE SCHOOL- Swimming lessons

Date: 28th January, 2025

Dear Parent/Carer,

Each week this term, from week 2 to week 9, our students will take part in swimming lessons at the AquaJets Swim school and North Rockhampton pool.

- Students will be supervised and taught by trained coaches as well as volunteers and teacher aides. The ratio of students to adults will be 5:1 or less.
- Students will travel by bus to and from the pool. They will leave the school approximately half an hour before their allocated swimming lesson time
- Students will have 45minute lessons and then return to school
- Students will need to bring togs, a sun shirt, a towel and thongs in a plastic bag
- Students may wear goggles if they wish but it is not compulsory
- Parents are welcome to come along to help with teaching or supervision. Please see the office if you are interested in helping out.

The classes lesson times are as follows:

Yr P-1 – Leave school at 12.00pm -> in the water at 12.15pm

Yr 2-3-4 – Leave school at 12.45pm-> in the water at 1pm

Yr 5/6 – Leave school at 1.30pm -> in the water at 1.45pm

All students will return to school by 3pm.

Activity Costs:

The cost for these lessons will be \$10 for the term per child.

The teaching of swimming is a a part of the Australian Curriculum and is a compulsory part of our school programme. If you are experiencing difficulties making this payment please see me to see how I can help.
